FEE STRUCTURE AND POLICY

CHILD'S NAME:

- \$ 46.00 per calendar month - 1 lesson per week
- \$ 90.00 per calendar month - 2 Lessons per week
- Private Lessons - \$ 20.00 (15 minute Lesson) - Pay 1 in Advance
\$ 35.00 (30 minute lesson) - Pay 1 in Advance
- THIRD CHILD SWIMS AT HALF PRICE!*

MISSED LESSONS

- If child is unable to attend scheduled lesson, 12 hours notice is required to receive a make up lesson.
- Limit of 1 make up lesson per calendar month.
- Make up lessons to be taken in a vacant lesson time - Different to the normal block lesson time, where available.
- Make up lesson must be arranged within 2 weeks of cancelled lesson or lesson is forfeited.
- If no notice is given, lesson and fee is for forfeited.
- The following month MUST be paid for on the last lesson of the current month or you may forfeit your timeslot.
- Refunds are not available so we encourage communication with the venue.
- If credit is required due to an extended illness, a letter and medical certificate will be required to be sent to the committee for consideration.
- A holding fee of \$5.50 per lesson is payable to hold your timeslot if going on holidays.

GENERAL INFORMATION

What to bring

- Towels for your child and yourself where applicable
- Dry clothes to change into after the lesson
- Appropriate swim wear - It is compulsory for infants to wear swimming nappies for babies. Eg Huggies Little Swimmers.
- Swimming cap and goggles optional

We recommend that your child wears the swim wear that they are accustomed to, for example, if your child frequents the beach in rash shirt and board shorts, we strongly recommend that they wear this in their lesson.

Help at Home

Here at Grace, we believe that an early introduction to the water is of tremendous benefit in building strength, mobility and of course, an affinity with the water, therefore, we encourage infants to join the program from the age of six months, we do not take infants younger than six months, due to immunisation recommendations.

As a parent, it is a good idea to prepare your child beforehand by getting them excited and familiar with starting lessons.

For children commencing in the Starfish level, it is a good idea to utilise their bath time by introducing them to some of the activities that they will be taking part in during the lesson, for example, the infants and Parents/Caregivers, will be singing nursery rhymes and playing games so they associate being in the water with fun, so we appreciate if you could introduce some of these elements at home

Swimming During Winter

Our Learn to Swim pools are heated to a comfortable temperature of between 30 - 34 degrees, so swimming all year round is not only practical, but available and recommended.

Research has proven that you do not catch the cold virus simply by being cold. We do suggest however, that parents/caregivers provide a dry change of clothes, and that children change out of their wet clothes as soon as possible for your child's comfort. We also recommend that you provide a warm drink for your child once they have completed their lesson.

Parent Teacher Interaction

We endeavour to give your child the best aquatic education possible.

If at any time you have a question regarding our lesson plan, please don't hesitate to ask our administration staff. We welcome all inquires and are happy to arrange for your child's instructor to contact you outside of lesson time to discuss any questions or queries.

Health Concerns

Should I consult my Doctor before starting lessons?

It is not generally necessary to have you child visit the doctor before starting the Learn to Swim program, unless you are concerned about a medical condition they may already have such as epilepsy. It is recommended though for certain conditions that a consultation should be sought. It is compulsory to complete a Confidential Medical Form before your child's program commences.

For every child's benefit we request that anyone suffering from any of the below mentioned conditions do not partake in lessons:

Chicken Pox	until 7 days after the last lesion has healed
Dysentery	until 10 days after the last bout.
Measles	until 7 days after the rash appears
Mumps	until 14 days after symptoms appear.
Ring Worm	until treatment is successful
School Sores	until lesions are fully healed
Whooping Cough	until 4 weeks after the bout
Itises (Laryngitis etc)	until clear
